The staff and children are so excited to welcome you to our Federated Sports Day on **Friday 20th June**. Ahead of the day, we wanted to provide you with some important information:

What is the timetable for the day?

9:15am – 11:45am	Junior School Sports Day (Prize giving at 11:30)
11:55pm – 12:50pm	Whole Federation Family Picnic
1pm – 3pm	Infant School Sports Day (Prize giving at 2:45)

What does my child need to wear?

Your child will need to wear P.E kit into school and wear a plain t-shirt to match their house colour.

The houses and their colours are:

Walbury – **Blue**

Sidbury - **Red**

Danebury - **Yellow**

Fosbury – **Green**



If you are unsure which house your child belongs to, please ask their class teacher who will be happy to help. Year R children will have a note in their diary indicating which house they are in.

If the weather is hot, please ensure your child is wearing sun cream and has a hat to wear outside.



Refreshments, Programmes and New for this Year...

The following items will be available to purchase on the day, from the tipi and/or entry gate:

- Ice pops, at lunch time for **40p**
- Bottled water, on entry and at lunch-time for **50p**
- Programmes on entry, for **40p** which will contain a timetable of events and a map
- Tickets to enter our coconut shy competition to win a family prize! **50p** for two shots

If you don't want to bring cash on the day, you can purchase programmes, ice pop tokens, water tokens, and game tokens from the Hive, before and after school between the 16th and 19th of June.

What are the arrangements for picnic lunch?

We are excited to invite you to join us to have a picnic lunch on the playground with your child.

Please ensure you have completed the lunch time arrangement slip for your child by Monday 16th of June.

Access to the playground will be through the Infant School gate on **Holly Walk** pathway. The gate will be open at **11:45am** and closed at **11:55am promptly**. This is to ensure the gate can be closed over lunch time to ensure the safety of our children.



At **11.55am** you will be able to pick your child up from their classroom door for picnic lunch. **Your child's class teacher will only release to the adult named on the lunch time arrangement slip.**

Please remember to cancel your child's hot meal if you have ordered in advance and plan to take them for picnic instead.

At **12.50pm** a bell will ring for children return to their classrooms, **with their adult** to sign back in.

At **12.55pm** the gate will open again to allow parents to leave, or to enter if they are not able to attend the picnic lunch. The gate will close again at **1pm sharp**. Any arrivals after this time will need to sign in at the Junior School admin office.

Please feel free to bring blankets and chairs along to the picnic, as these will not be provided by the federation.
