Dear Families,

We are excited to announce our summer term trip to the Titanic Museum on **Tuesday 21st April 2026**. This will support our inspirational curriculum and will link with our History learning centred on 'The Sinking of the Titanic'.

Visiting the Titanic Museum will:

- Provide a structured workshop where the children will explore artefacts from the ship
- Allow for an investigation into the reasons for the Titanic sinking
- Enable the children to learn about the ways Southampton has changed since the disaster
- Provide the children with an incredible sensory experience

Arrangements for the day:

We will be travelling by coach, which will leave school at 9am and return at approximately 3pm.

On the day, children will need:

- Full school uniform
- A waterproof coat
- A named water bottle or plastic bottle
- A packed lunch in a named bag

If you would like to order a packed lunch from Dolce, you will need to do so via SchoolGrid. Please note, if you have not ordered a packed lunch on SchoolGrid by **Friday 17th April 2026**, you will need to provide your child with a packed lunch on the day. Please note that menu is not yet available. We will notify you when this is available in due course.

We are asking for a parental contribution of £16.84 per child which will include entrance to the SeaCity museum, the workshop experience, a guided tour and the coach.
