What does my child need to wear?

Your child will need to wear PE kit into school and wear a plain t-shirt to match their house colour.

The houses and their colours are:

If you are unsure which house your child belongs to, please ask their class teacher who will be happy to help. Year R children will have a note in their diary indicating which house they are in.

If the weather is hot, please ensure your child is wearing sun cream and has a hat to wear outside.

- Tickets to enter our coconut shy competition to win a family prize! **£1 for 5 shots**

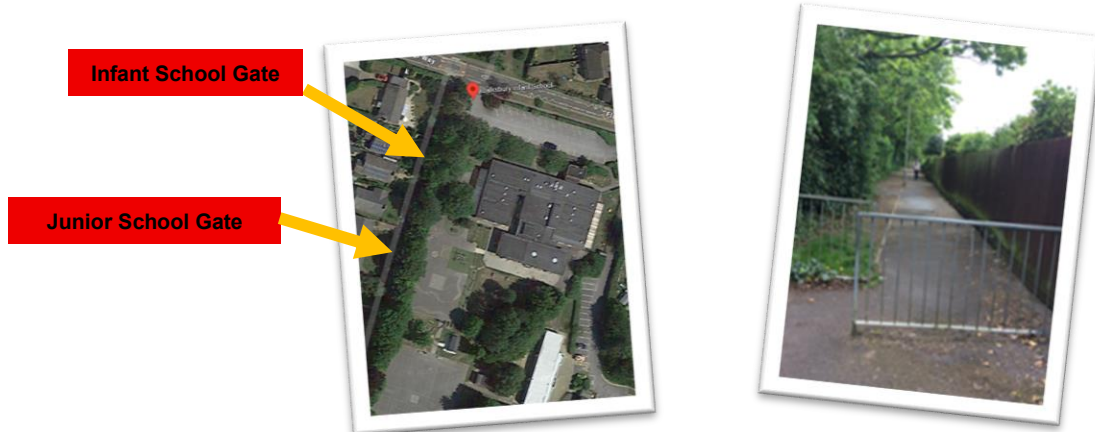
A reminder that this will be a cash only event. Programmes are available to purchase ahead of time during the week beginning Monday 18th May, before and after school at The Hive.

What are the arrangements for picnic lunch?

We are excited to invite you to join us to have a picnic lunch on the playground with your child.

Please ensure you have completed the lunch time arrangement slip for your child by Friday 22nd May.

Access to the playground **after 8:45am** will be through the **Infant School gate** on **Sycamore Path**. The gate will be open at **11:45am** and closed at **11:55am promptly**. This is to ensure the gate can be closed over lunch time to ensure the safety of our children.



At **11.55am** you will be able to pick your child up **from their classroom door** for picnic lunch. **Your child's class teacher will only release to the adult named on the lunch time arrangement slip.**

At **12.50pm** a bell will ring for children **return to their classrooms, with their adult** to sign them back in.

At **12.55pm** the Junior School playground gate will open to allow families to leave. The Infant school gate will open to allow entry for any families not attending the picnic lunch. The gates will close again at **1pm sharp**.

Please feel free to bring blankets and chairs along to the picnic, as these will not be provided by the federation.
