We welcomed Councillor Brooks in to see our wonderful reflection garden. Thank you to all those that have helped us over the years to achieve the calming space it has become.

Balksbury Infant and Junior Schools in Andover recently welcomed Cllr Zilliah Brooks for a tour of their beautiful reflection garden - a calm, sensory-rich space designed to support children's emotional wellbeing.

Funded through a £1,000 Councillor Community Grant in 2023, the garden has become a vital part of school life. It's used daily for quiet playtimes, emotional support sessions, and moments of reflection - especially for children processing grief or big feelings.

Once an unused patch of ground, it's now filled with bamboo, pebbled paths, and memory stones, offering a gentle place to pause, talk, or simply feel safe.

During the visit, Cllr Brooks also heard about 'The Hive' - the school's brilliant PTA-run uniform swap shop - and discussed ways the school hopes to grow the garden with support from the wider community.
