Fortnite is one of the most popular video franchises in the world.

What is Fortnite?

An online multiplayer video game, where players must collect weapons, build forts and shoot other players to defeat them.

There are multiple game modes within Fortnite. 6 of these modes are created and managed by Epic Games. The remaining modes are made by other Fortnite players, so may not have the same safety features.

Epic Games Fortnite modes



The most well-known game. Loot, build, explore and fight in a game of 100 players to be the last one standing



Players collaborate to protect the survivor base from zombie-like creatures. A pay-to-play game



Lego® and Fortnite collide - a collection of Lego® based games experiences



Players create their own personalised island and design their own games they can share with other players



Up to 12 players race with each other on a growing selection of race tracks



Perform solo or play in a band with friends on stage

What can I play Fortnite on?

Fortnite is available on lots of devices including PlayStation 4, PlayStation 5, Xbox One, Xbox Series X/S, Nintendo Switch, PCs, iPhone and Android mobiles.

It also features cross-platform play, where players can play with each other when using different devices.

What is the age rating?

This depends on which version of the game is being played.

In the UK, **Fortnite** has a PEGI age rating of 12+.

This particularly applies to **Fortnite Battle Royale**, due to its frequent scenes of mild violence. Often the violence is cartoonish, but it may upset some players.



Fortnite Festival also has a PEGI age rating of 12+, due to the use of bad language and sexual nature of the lyrics.



Lego Fortnite has a PEGI age rating of 7+, making it more suitable for younger players.

Rocket Racing has a PEGI age rating of 3+

What is a Cabined Account?

An account that provides a safe experience for younger players, if they indicate that they are under 13. They will need to provide a parent's email address in order to receive parental consent to access certain features such as voice chat.

What do some of the terms used in Fortnite mean?

Chapter - regular updates to the game, which usually last a year or two. They give players a new map to play on, as well as other new features

Season - each chapter is divided into multiple seasons, which last around 90 days each. They come with smaller map changes, new themes and new battle passes

Skin - an outfit or cosmetic change to the appearance of a player's character

Emote - a special animation that your character can perform, such as dances and gestures

Experience Points - gained by players by completing specific challenges through combat, building and looting. Experience points (or 'XP') allow players to advance to the next level

Battle Pass - an item bundle that players can exchange for experience points to receive rewards. There are 2 types of a Battle Pass – a free pass which gives a small number of items and a paid premium pass which gives over 100 rewards

V-Bucks - Fortnite's in-game currency used to purchase new 'skins' and items. Players use real money to purchase different amounts of V-Bucks

Loot Llama - a type of item bundle that offers lots of rewards when opened, which can be purchased or earned through gameplay

Is Fortnite safe?

Some versions of Fortnite are generally safe for children, especially those rated 3+ or 7+. However, there are things every parent should be aware of:

Inappropriate content

Players can play with people around the world and use the chat feature to communicate with each other. This could put a child at **risk of being exposed to inappropriate language or content**

Interacting with other players

Fortnite is an online multiplayer game, which means that it is very likely your child will be playing with others online, including strangers. The chat feature in Fortnite could put a child risk of receiving upsetting comments or unwanted contact from unknown people

In-Game Purchases

Although Fortnite is free to download and play, players are given options to use real money to buy in-game currency (V-Bucks), items Loot Llamas or Battle Passes. This could put a child at risk of spending large amounts of real money, building up a debt

Screen Time

Players are encouraged to start new battles once one has ended. There is no option to pause or save a game during a battle. This could put a child at **risk** of spending hours playing online



- Customise the voice and text chat feature so that you know who your child is chatting to. If your child is under 10 years old, the maximum voice chat permission will be "Friends Only" and text chat will be off. If your child is under 13, the maximum voice and text chat permission will be "Friends & Teammates." When your child turns 13, you will be able to choose additional voice and text chat options
- Talk with your child about who they are playing with and/or chatting with in the ingame chat. Make sure they know to tell you if they see something upsetting
- Sign up to receive weekly playtime reports so that you can track the amount of time your child is playing Fortnite
- Enable mature language filter to stop your child seeing inappropriate language in chats
- Set a PIN to prevent unauthorised payments so that your child does not spend real money in the game
- Set time limits so that your child does not spend hours playing on it
- Set a PIN for friend requests so that you can control the friend requests your child send or receives
- Know how to block or report a concern about a player
- Set up parental controls on the device your child is using as well as those in the game

Attendance

School Day Times

Your child will be marked late if they have not arrived.

Your child will be marked late if they have not arrived.

Lateness

Children who are late must be signed in by an adult via the school reception.

Parents may be issued with a penalty notice for persistent lateness, which is 10 unauthorised late codes (U) within a 10 week period.



Reporting absence

If your child is unwell, please notify the school office on the absent line **stating the reason of absence** (just 'unwell' or 'poorly' is not appropriate) **before the start of school.** We cannot accept a message via a sibling.

If no contact has been made, a member of staff will call. If we are unable to make contact, a home visit will be made to ensure that the family are OK.

On day 3 of illness, Mrs Whatley or Mrs Grinham, our CSLs will make a Welfare call to check in and see how your child is feeling and whether any other support is required.
