of how beautifully the children sang - the priest said they were much better than his usual


congregation!

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

#### **Balksbury Come Dancing**

Building upon a fantastic start to sport this academic year the children have been captivated in our Balksbury Come Dancing extravaganza. From Year R learning the turns and spins of the Waltz, Year 3 going back in time to learn the Charleston, Year 5 focusing on a more modern contemporary street dance and finally Year 6 upping the tempo with Jump and Jive. It has been wonderful to walk through the Federation and see the energy that the children are putting into their dances. The smiles on their faces and the collaboration being shown to create their version of the dances that they have learnt.

It has been a privilege to take part in P.E. lessons across the Federation. In Year 1, the children have been developing the fundamentals of ball skills, learning basic movements and techniques that will support them as they progress through the school. Year 2 has completed their fitness block, exploring the cardiovascular system, stamina, and strength, and working hard in each lesson to demonstrate their understanding.

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
