ESafety

TikTok is one of the most popular social media apps on the planet.



TikTok currently has 1.7 billion monthly active users.

What is TikTok?

TikTok is primarily a social media App where users can create, watch and livestream short video clips which are often accompanied by music.

Common videos often include:

- Dance routines
- Lip-syncing to music
- Clips from TV shows or films
- Sports
- Make-up tips
- Comedy sketches
- New and world events

Users do not need an account to watch videos on TikTok. But if a user wants to like, comment, customise their feed or create their own video, then they will need to sign up for a free account.

How does TikTok work?

Users can browse for videos via a personalised feed known as the 'For You Page'.

TikTok uses algorithms to show the user videos based on their interests and other videos they watch.

What is the age rating?

TikTok has an age rating of 13+.

When logging in for the first time, the user will be asked to log in using either their email, their Google account, or by linking TikTok to one of their other social media accounts, for instance Facebook or Twitter.

Key TikTok terms

- Profile your personal page which shows your username, nickname, profile picture, bio and videos etc.
- For You Feed a personalised feed of content based on your interests
- Following Feed shows videos from the people you follow
- **Discover** allows users to search for and explore content
- LIVE allows users to broadcast video content in real-time. You must be at least 16 to host a livestream
- **Duet** allows users to create a split-screen video alongside an existing video
- **Stitch** allows users to use a clip from another person's video in their own video
- **Effect** a special tool where you can add/change features of your video such as the appearance, colours, background etc.
- Sound any audio that accompanies a video
- Hearts used to show how many people have watched and liked the video. The more hearts a video has, the more likely it is to be seen by other people around the world
- Comments publicly viewable statements that are posted on individual videos
- **Direct messages** private messages sent to individuals or a selected group of people

What are the risks?

- **Seeing inappropriate content Once the app** has been downloaded, users will be able to see all the content without creating an account. This includes videos with inappropriate language and content. However, the user will not be able to post, like or share anything until they have set up an account
- **Receiving contact from strangers** users can like/react to a video, follow an account or send messages to each other. There is a risk that strangers will be able to directly contact children
- Unvetted and unmonitored videos TikTok's guidelines prohibits the sharing of illegal or inappropriate content, but the sheer volume of videos uploaded, means they are not manually monitored and vetted
- Dangerous challenges some users have been influenced by videos they have watched to perform 'challenges' which can be harmful, criminal or even deadly
- **In-app spending** TikTok is free, but users can buy TikTok coins to use to purchase emojis in the app
- Addictive some users can become addicted to watching and creating videos, spending hours online
- Personalised unsuitable content TikTok's algorithms will find videos for a user to watch based on their interests and things they have searched for/commented on. If a user has accidentally clicked on inappropriate content, then the algorithm may then suggest more unsuitable content for them to see. Watching and commenting (even negatively) can send more related content to their feed
- Links to other apps Under-16s cannot send or receive private messages. But once users have made contact, e.g. through comments on videos, they can switch to another app like Snapchat to chat privately and swap images and videos

Keeping safe



Family Pairing

Connect your child's account with your own. It gives you access to parental controls to help manage who they can speak to and how long they can spend on the app

Private account

Set your child's account to private - only approved followers will be able to watch their videos. Public accounts mean their content is viewable on or off TikTok - they may appear in search engines, and even news sites

Restricted mode

Filter out videos that may contain inappropriate or adult topics and stop them appearing on your child's 'For You Page'

Comment filters

Filter who can comment on your child's videos and stop unwanted/inappropriate comments from appearing on their feed

Direct messages

Manage who can contact your child privately on the app. You can choose who can send them direct messages by selecting 'Friends only' or 'No one'

Daily screen time

Allows you to manage how long your child can spend on the app. You can set a daily time limit, and once the time is up a passcode is needed to keep using it

Restrict in-app purchases

Set to restrict your child from spending TikTok coins which are bought with real money

Block and report

Report videos or block users where there are concerns. Click either 'Report' or 'Block' from the drop-down menu. You will also be asked to give a description of your concern

Family Nurture Programme

This course is not about telling you how to raise your children.

It does not criticise, judge or put you down.

Attending a group isn't about judging your motives for being there. Children don't come with a manual, there is no 'one-size-fits-all' approach to raising children and there's no such thing as a perfect parent either. We won't lecture you on how to parent your children. It's a safe environment to explore what might be causing some of those challenging behaviours and offers you tried-and-tested techniques you may wish to try at home.

There's no pressure or expectation put on any parent to talk in the group if they don't want to, everyone has the right to pass.

What parents say:

'I was really cynical that anything could work, but it's really making a difference for me and my children'

'I was surprised how even the smallest changes at home have made such a big difference.'

'I thought I'd be judged but everyone has been so supportive and it's nice to know I'm not the only one.'
