We are sorry if anyone believes this is the case. The Leadership Team and Mrs Sanderson who leads Behaviour and Attitudes will investigate this and ensure the whole team understands that this should not happen.

#### There is too much communication!

Yes this is a tricky one. Different families have different views and regularly give us different feedback

We have reduced the number of App messages since the last survey and have received comments about this. We have also received positive comments about the use of reading diaries.

Many of our families want to be well informed about school life and the federated community.

The Leadership Team will continue to discuss what improvements we can make with our Admin Team.

#### Can we have more competitive sport teams and games?

The school will take on board your response and discuss it as a Leadership Team alongside Mr Bensaid who leads Sport, and Mrs Cordner and Miss Romain who lead PE, and we will look at what else we could, or should do

Balksbury is working hard to revitalise sports teams sport and has in the last year, organised cluster football matches. The school take part in John Hanson primary sport of netball and hockey, which is what they offer and have done over the last two years. The school are also organising a morning 'Festival of Sport' for local schools in the summer. Included in our week are lunchtime training for netball, hockey and football. The federation do also offer a range of sport and active play including weekly swimming lessons in the summer for Year 2

and above, which other schools do not offer, Active play at break and lunchtime including a Move More challenge, upper and lower body agility equipment, an outside gym to name just a few things.

#### Can we have physical homework?

Yes

Homework is a statutory requirement. We moved to online homework during the pandemic and made further changes based on responses to this questionnaire last year. However, too many of our pupils are not engaging with online homework. We have discussed this a lot and listened to what you have said.

We will be reintroducing homework books in September.

#### Can we have more project homework?

We ended project homework as many families told us this was a time constraint on their personal family time.


The Leadership Team will discuss whether we should return to this as an optional additional homework.

#### What happened to the junior leadership team?



#### Results


We received 106 responses. Please find below the results from the questionnaire:

My child has been bullied and the school dealt with the bullying quickly and effectively



We do not tolerate bullies at Balksbury.







My child has SEND, and the school gives them the support they need to succeed












There is a good range of subjects available to my child at Balksbury Junior School
